*The Canadian Nurses Association is pleased to be offering two administrations of the Canadian Nurse Practitioner Examination: Family/All Ages (CNPE: F/AA) in 2006 – **May 24 and October 25.***

CNA, in collaboration with the Canadian Nurse Practitioner Initiative, developed the exam for the licensure of nurse practitioners (NPs) in all Canadian jurisdictions. The first exam was successfully administered on November 9, 2005.

CNA will be recruiting NP short-answer marker volunteers from those jurisdictions that will be participating in the CNPE: F/AA. If you are interested in participating in exam-related activities, please contact your regulatory body.

CNA's objective is to support NPs to become recognized and employed across Canada as essential health-care team members and to improve Canadians' access to quality health services.
